SLO Blues Baseball Release 2021 Season Schedule

San Luis Obispo, CA – After the cancelation of their 2020 season, the San Luis Obispo Blues Baseball Organization released their patiently awaited 2021 season schedule. The team’s season opens on the road Friday, June 11th against the Lincoln Potters in Lincoln, California, for a three (3) game set. The Blues will host their first home-game at Sinsheimer Stadium against the Walnut Creek Crawdads on Tuesday, June 15th at 6:00 pm.

The team’s season will run from Friday, June 11th, through Friday, August 6th, with a total of 43 games. The Blues’ are scheduled to play 27 home games, 16 away games, a league All-Star game (July 14th), and the California Collegiate League (CCL) playoffs.

Over those 43 games, the Blues will compete against some of highest-caliber teams in the country. The Blues’ opponents include eight (8) CCL teams; featuring six (6) games against the 2019 CCL and State Champions (Santa Barbara Foresters) and a home series against the Blues’ 50-year rival and northern powerhouse, the Humboldt Crabs Friday, June 25th- Sunday, June 27th.

The 2021 season will include many of the promotional events the organization is known for such as three post-game firework shows (June 18th, July 3rd, July 29th), seven (7) theme nights, two (2) youth camps, and a home-run derby fundraiser.

The Blues’ newest additions to the staff are Bob Miller, Head Coach at Cuesta College, and Ted Lilly, Former Major League Baseball All-Star. After months of hard work, Coach Bob Miller confidently stated “I am looking forward to the 2021 summer with the Blues! We have a talented roster of players committed from quality programs throughout the country. The Blues administration staff and coaches are prepared and excited to present a great baseball product to our fans! The 2021 CCL baseball season cannot get here soon enough!”

Due to the unknown circumstances surrounding public gatherings, the Blues’ have postponed the availability of ticket sales, and will notify the Blues community when there is a clearer picture surrounding public health guidelines. Regardless of the ticketing policies, the Blues plan to offer various streaming packages so fans can follow the 2021 season from the comfort of their home.
